  - a. President Harrison Keller, UNT President
    - i. Background: 6 generation Texan, grew up in the panhandle. Both parents school teachers, undergrad at University of Notre Dame, first got to know UNT with reputation of music program- he was a pretty serious high school and college musician, commissioner higher ed in state of Texas. UNT is no place he would rather be- some for obvious stuff for growth in region, most dynamic economy but it is really the people open to innovation, thinking outside of the box. We have a responsibility to think creatively about the role we need to play for our students, region, state.
    - ii. 3 Strategic Priorities
      - 1. Strategic Budgeting
        - a. More than 46,000 students, billion dollar a year university. Need to be much more strategic about using our resources.

#### 2. Research

a. 50 million dollars in the Texas Research fund over the next several years. Want to find where we can do the most impactful research for the state where we can lead; data science, data analytics, AI, learning sciences

#### 3. Student Success

- a. 40% students eligible for Pell, more than 40% first generation college students
- b. Want to make sure these students aren't the first to attend college but the first to graduate. Focus on raising the bar even further- need to make sure students have knowledge skills, credentials, experiences- momentum into their career.
- c. Survey for open ended answers on student success sent out today to staff, students, faculty.

### iii. Reconstituted the Cabinet

  - Student leaders from across campus for unfiltered feedback on student experiences
